

NOTIFICATION: SR 84 Expressway Widening and SR 84/I-680 Interchange Improvements Project

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), in cooperation with the Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC), has released the Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment (EIR/EA) for the State Route (SR) 84 Expressway Widening and SR 84/Interstate 680 (I-680) Interchange Improvements Project. Caltrans is the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Alameda CTC is the implementing agency for the preliminary design and environmental review phase.

The project proposes to widen and conform SR 84 to expressway standards between south of Ruby Hill Drive and the I-680 interchange in southern Alameda County. The project would also improve SR 84/I-680 interchange ramps and extend the existing southbound I-680 High Occupancy Vehicle/express lane northward by approximately 2 miles. The purpose of the proposed project is to alleviate traffic congestion, improve operations and safety, and improve bicycle access on SR 84 and at the SR 84/I-680 interchange.
