

TO RESERVE TICKETS:

Email sunoltrain@sunol.net and provide your name, physical Sunol home address and phone number. There is a strict limit of 4 tickets per family. Keep in mind that there are 25% fewer tickets available this year (compared to 2022) and many Sunol families are eager to ride the train. Tickets will be allocated on a *first come, first serve* basis, based on the date and time of the email.

TO PICK-UP YOUR TICKETS:

Reserved tickets will be held for pick-up at the Sunol Depot Station on November 24 from 3:00 to 6:00PM. Plan to show your identification matching the reservation name and physical address (not a P.O. Box). If reserved tickets are returned or aren't picked up by 6:00PM, they will be made available to families on the waiting list.
